ABSTRACTS GUIDELINES

At the Lab To Field Congress 2024, a poster session will be organized to provide an opportunity to present **international innovations** on the theme of **"Starch and non-structural carbohydrates in horse nutrition"**, in the form of a **poster** (Ao). Instructions for writing the abstract are given below:



The abstract must be written in **French** or **British English**.



The summary must be written in a **Word document**. The margins of the document should be 2.5 cm on the left and right, top and bottom. An example of the style is given below :

Abstract title short and evocative (Raleway, 12 pt, bold)

Co-author, A.¹, Co-author, B.^{1,2}, <u>Speaker, C.</u>² (Raleway, 10 pt, italic)

<u>CorrespondingAdress@mail.com</u> (Raleway, 10 pt, normal)

¹Laboratory ... (Raleway, 8 pt, italic)

Abstract (Raleway, 12 pt, normal, side-justified alignment): In the case of research work, the abstract must include the work hypothesis, the experimental design, the results and the main conclusions.

Bibliographic references (in limited numbers): Durant et al. 2023. J. Eq. Nutr. 78, 25-36. (Raleway, 8 pt, normal)



2500 characters maximum (including title, authors, affiliations, bibliographical references and spaces).



Abbreviations must be explained when first used, except standard abbreviations such as EDTA, ELISA, ATP, etc.
